# AMERICAN EXCELLENCE

By the mid-nineteenth century, divided by principle and ideology, a great Civil War ravaged a young America. At the moment when our nation faced its greatest threat, an innovative art rose to fruition. The Hudson River School movement was uniquely American and virtually without correlation to any prior artistic endeavor. Unbound by a European convention that emphasized humanity over nature, these maverick painters ventured into the vast territories of the new world and brought to canvas unimaginable natural wonders. With an escalating urgency, our artists refined their talents and imparted a passion for the homeland that has endured as a testament to the sanctity of our nation's profound beauty. Today, a people alienated by opposing political views may find a healing commonality in a land forever preserved on the canvases of the Hudson River School.

Nations across the globe have featured works of the Hudson River School in a multitude of exhibitions in recognition of their innovation and universal importance. As a relatively young country, we have not yet come to fully appreciate and value our most enduring paintings. With just a finite number of these works available for acquisition, combined with the inevitability of inflation and burgeoning interest, we should act with haste to seize the present opportunity.


